OPERATIONS ORDER

1. MISSION:

Miami Enterprise Cadet Squadron and Homestead Air Reserve Base Cadet Squadron will be hosting an Airman Leadership School at Homestead Air Reserve Base. The purpose of this activity will be to train cadets in the basics of CAP history, uniform wear, drill and ceremonies, and customs and courtesies.

2. EXECUTION:

- a) Students are to arrive between 0800-0900 hours on the 3rd of March 2012.
- b) Uniform of the Day: authorization for travel and arrival in BDUs. Check in will be in BDUs

3. TRANSPORTATION:

Participants will have to find their own form of transportation. The activity will be held at Homestead Air Reserve Base 29050 Coral Sea Boulevard, Homestead Base, Florida Building 160.

4. FINAL FORMATION:

Departure will be from Homestead Air Reserve Base at 1430 on the 4th of March 2012.

5. SAFETY:

In order to participate at this activity all members must be safety current or they will be sent home.

6. STUDENT APPLICATIONS:

NOTE: Cadets must have a current CAP membership card.

1. A completed FLWG Form 500 (*including Squadron Commander AND parent signatures*)
2. **Two** completed CAPF 60s
3. 20 dollars (\$10 cash or check made out to Group 7)
4. Must Have ALL safety requirements!
5. **Online Application**

7. CONDUCT:

While at the activity, everyone will be expected to maintain a professional level of conduct becoming of Civil Air Patrol members. The Cadet Honor Code will be strictly enforced, and Cadets posing disciplinary problems may be sent home, if directed by the Activity Commander

8. EQUIPMENT:

All items must be labeled with your LAST NAME and the 6 digits of your CAPID.
Example: Cadet Smith, CAPID 370000 will label all items **Smith370000** in permanent marker.

a) BDUs

1. 1-2 set of BDUs with appropriate patches
2. 1 Army/Air Force Woodland Patrol Cap
3. 1 blue Air Force belt with subdued buckle for BDUs
4. 2-4 **BROWN or OLIVE DRAB** T-shirts for BDUs
 - a. **BLACK shirts are reserved for Staff**
5. 1 pair “well broken-in” black boots
6. AT LEAST 3 pairs of boot socks

b) PTU

1. White Shirt
2. Athletic Shorts (Black/Blue)
3. Athletic Shoes

c) SLEEPING

1. Appropriate sleepwear
2. Sleeping bag and blanket

MISC ITEMS

Note: You must be able to carry everything you bring to this activity by yourself and without making multiple trips. Soft-sided duffel bags are preferred over hard suitcases.

1. Personal toiletries
2. Poncho or rain gear
3. **Notebook**
4. Pens and Pencils
5. Hydration Gear (Camelbak/Canteens)

c) MEDICATION

All cadets must submit a CAPF 504. All medications (including over-the-counter items) **must be** in the original containers. Pharmacy labeled containers with individual’s name, medication name, and dispensing instructions required for prescription medicine. All cadets must notify the medical officer of all medication upon arrival.

d) PROHIBITED ITEMS

Do not, under any circumstance, bring items that are not listed on the equipment list (i.e. CD players, any sort of video games, MP3 players, Laptops, etc).

e) POVs

Any cadet bringing a privately owned vehicle will be required to secure the vehicle and turn in the keys to the Activity staff. If you drive your personal vehicle, be sure to bring proof of insurance, license and registration.
